Minutes - Twelfth Annual Meeting held October 25 and 26, 1957 in P.U.D.  
Auditorium at Moses Lake, Washington.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the group go on record as favoring the sale of irrigable State lands in Irrigation Districts.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that recommendations of the Nominating Committee be accepted and the Secretary be instructed to cast a unanimous ballot for the following:

- President - Keith J. McDaniels - one year.
- Vice Presidents - R. W. Hendrick - one year  
- Lloyd Berry - one year.
- Director Division 2 - Rogers R. Neff - three years. To succeed Harold J. Eidemiller whose term expires this year.
- Director Division 3 - Gale L. Sterling - three years. To succeed himself for another three years.
- Director Division 4 - David P. Brown - one year. To fill vacancy of R. W. Hendrick for unexpired term.
- At Large - Van E. Nutley - three years. To succeed Howard M. Cameron whose term expires this year.
- At Large - Malcolm J. Crawford - one year. To succeed Earl S. Gregory who is unable to continue for the rest of his unexpired term.


Motion was then made to appoint Ted Newtrum as Secretary-Treasurer for the ensuing year. Motion was seconded and carried.
