The meeting was called to discuss the new Department of Ecology and to select persons whose names could be recommended by the Association to the Governor for appointment to the committee which will serve the Department as an advisory Commission. Those names submitted were Loren Markham, Doyle Mathews, Gilbert J. Sheffels, Jerry Sandlin and Bill Phillips.

It was moved by Vancik, seconded by Thomas and carried that three names be submitted to the Governor.

It was moved by Liebel, seconded by Stepon and carried that Doyle Mathews be listed as choice number 1.

It was moved by Smith, seconded by Vancik and carried that Loren Markham be second choice.

It was moved by Vancik, seconded by Alexander and carried that Jerry Sandlin be third choice.

It was moved by Nutley, seconded by Thomas and carried that the President be authorized and directed to make a trip to Olympia with the letter and to contact the Presidents of the State Reclamation Association and the Development League and ask them to accompany him.

Henry Vancik reported on the March 17th Hearing by the Interim Committee on H.B. 486. He stated that the chairman permitted those attending to give a history of the bill and that the State Mediator didn't know where the irrigation districts belong in relation to matters concerning the Department of Labor and Industries.

Loren Markham reported that there seems to be some softening in appropriations, and that Jim Smith and Ellis Armstrong are trying to get money released.

No action was taken on legislative matters which were discussed.

It was moved by Nutley, seconded by Thomas and carried that the Annual Meeting of the State Association of Washington Irrigation Districts be held in Yakima on Thursday, October 29th, 1970.

It was announced that there would be a Directors meeting on August 7 at Paul Lemargie's office in Ephrata to complete plans for the Annual meeting.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
