Washington State Legislative matters were discussed. It was moved by Nutley, seconded by Hendrick and carried that Henry Vancik be authorized to set the ceiling on the vandalism bill penalty at any amount desirable to the committee.

The problems encountered in dealing with County Treasurers were again discussed. It was moved by Nutley, seconded by House and carried that unless South District can come up with something acceptable to the County Treasurers and to the State Association, the bill which is presently before the Legislative committee in Olympia should be permitted to die.

Letter from Robert Graham, State Auditor, concerning the possibility of having to charge all costs for audits to the organization being audited because of a reduction of funds to be received from the General Fund was also discussed. It was moved by McDaniels, seconded by Hendrick and carried that the Association write a letter to Mr. Graham supporting his efforts.

It was moved by House, seconded by Alexander and carried that the minutes of the meeting of December 9, 1970 be approved as written.

The Labor bill was again scheduled for a hearing. After a discussion of this and other Legislative matters, the meeting adjourned at 11:50 a.m.
