Leonard F. Jansen and E. F. Doncaster were also present.

Russell Smith began the discussion of the bills regarding erosion and pollution which are expected to come before the Legislative session which will start in January, 1972. All of those present took part in the discussion.

HJR 21 was also discussed at length.

Russ Smith informed those present that Mr. Biggs, Director of the Department of Ecology, had issued guidelines for the Implementation of the Shoreline Act. Eldon Thomas stated that there were two shoreline acts. E.F. Doncaster said he would get a copy of the bill in effect.

There followed a general discussion of the needs of the Association with regard to better representation at the legislative sessions. It was determined that an Executive Secretary was a possible means to furthering the interests of the irrigation districts. President McDaniels appointed Ed Ambruster and Eldon Thomas as a committee to study ways and means of raising money necessary to employ someone in the capacity of Executive Secretary.
